



CumberlandFest 2021 Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What are the location, dates and hours of operation for CumberlandFest 2021?

A. CumberlandFest takes place at Diamond Hill Park located at 4097 Diamond Hill Road, Cumberland, RI. The hours of operation are: Friday, August 6th from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m., Saturday, August 7th from noon to 11:00 p.m. and Sunday, August 8th from noon to 10:00 p.m.

Q. Is there a charge for parking?

A. No, parking is free at all lots. In addition to onsite parking at the park, overflow parking with shuttle bus service to and from satellite parking areas will be available on Saturday and Sunday nights starting at 5:30 o'clock and continuing until 30 minutes after closing. Overflow parking lots are located south of the park at the Bentley Baseball Fields (east side of Diamond Hill Road just north of the Diamond Hill Road/Nate Whipple Highway intersection) and at John Vianney Church, 3587 Diamond Hill Road.

Q. Can I use my credit or debit card to purchase tickets, food and other items during the event?

A. No, all transactions are cash only. For your convenience, ATM machines will be available at the park if you are in need of cash.

Q. Are rest room and hand washing facilities available at the park?

A. Port-a-johns, including family port-a-johns, and hand washing facilities will be available at convenient locations in the park.

Q. Will non-vaccinated guests be required to wear face masks?

A. Currently, Rhode Island does not require mask-wearing at outdoor events. CumberlandFest guests who wish to wear a mask may do so. Face masks will be available free of charge at the entrance gate for anyone who wants one.

Q. Is there a gate admission charge?

A. No, admission to CumberlandFest is free for the entire weekend.

Q. Does the midway include rides for kids?

A. Yes, there will be several rides that are suitable for little ones, plus free attractions and entertainment for children in the Food Court area.

Q. In previous years there have been time periods during the event when flat price unlimited ride tickets have been available. Will that be the case this year?

A. \$30 Wristbands will be available on Friday, Saturday and Sunday which will allow you to enjoy unlimited rides on the day of purchase.

Q. How can I make a contribution to CumberlandFest?

A. You can make out your contribution check to Cumberland Youth Activities Council (CYAC) and send it to CYAC, PO Box 7862, Cumberland, RI 02864. Write "CF 2021 contribution" on the memo line of your check. You will receive a thank you letter acknowledging your gift which you may use for tax purposes.
